

TOWN OF JONESBORO

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2020-004

An ordinance amending Chapter 2, Section 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Jonesboro to add Sections 2- 72, 2-73, and 2-74 fixing the compensation for the Town Clerk and the Town Tax Collector; Providing an amount of the bond required to be posted by each; providing effective date therefore and providing for matters related thereto.

WHEREAS, the salaries of the Town Clerk and the Town Tax Collector are required to be set by Ordinance and that the amount of the bond required by each is to be fixed by Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Town desires to maintain the present situation where the salaries for both positions are fixed by ordinance and the bond required for each position has not been fixed by ordinance; and,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Jonesboro in legal session duly convened as follows:

SECTION I

Section 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Jonesboro be and the same is hereby amended to enact Section 2-72, Section 2-73 and Section 2-74 to read as follows:

Section 2-72: The compensation for the Town Clerk be and the same is hereby salaried at the rate of \$20.00 per hour in addition to fringe benefits and retirement benefits.

Section 2-73: The compensation for the Town Tax Collector be and the same is hereby salaried at the rate of \$18.00 per hour in addition to fringe benefits and retirement benefits.

Section 2-73: Prior to assuming office, the Town Clerk and Town Tax collector shall be required to post a bond in favor of the Town in the amount of One Thousand dollars and no/100 (\$1,000)

SECTION II

This ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage.

Section III

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION IV

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Jonesboro that if any item or provision including any section, exception, part, phrase or term. Or the application thereof is held invalid; the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby. If any phrase, clause, word or other portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity shall be limited t that portion of the ordinance.
